

MPA - DSF Fundraiser



Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that allows families to raise money for their child's **DSF account** (*used to pay for trips, fees and other high school music-related expenses*) and for **Music Parents Association (MPA)** general fundraising (*used to supplement East/West/STEM music department budgets*).

SUMMARY

- Pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards.
- Gift cards are available to more than 700 of the country's biggest retailers, including grocery, department stores, gas stations, restaurants, hotels, home improvement, airlines and more.
- You order gift cards or e-cards from your computer or phone 24x7x365.
- You pay for the gift cards directly from your checking or savings account, so no forms or money need to be turned in.
- You pay face value for the gift card, but get a rebate of 1-25% deposited into your DSF account and MPA's general fundraising account. (Rebate is split 50-50.)
- E-Cards are delivered instantly. That means you can order one from your phone while shopping and use it to pay at the register. You can also customize e-cards and email them as a gift on the date you specify. (*note: your first e-card order or subsequent extra-large orders may have a short delay.*)
- The schedule for when physical gift cards will be delivered (and ordering deadlines) is posted on DHSMPA.org.
- By using Scrip to pay for your normal weekly purchases, you can easily raise \$500 or more per year!
- It takes 3-5 days to set up your Scrip account, so don't delay!
